

GUIDANCE FOR PURCHASERS

1. Conditions of Sale

Before bidding, all prospective purchasers should read carefully the Conditions of Sale.

2. Rostrum Announcements

All Lots are sold subject to any announcements that may be made from time to time from the Auctioneers' Rostrum and therefore it is the responsibility of all bidders to be in attendance at the commencement of the sale of a Lot to hear any such announcements.

3. Pre-Purchase Inspection of Lots & Paperwork

Prospective Purchasers are advised to inspect Lots in addition to vet certificates, vendor warranties and passports which should be checked in the main office prior to purchase.

4. Keep and Removal of Horses after Sale

Purchasers must make arrangements for the keep and attendance of the Lots from the Fall of the Hammer.

5. Release of Horses

A pass-out must be obtained from the main office prior to an animal being removed from the complex.

6. Private Sales

Where a horse is unsold in the sales ring and a purchaser agrees a price with the Vendor, with or without the assistance of an agent of Cavan Equestrian Centre, this transaction must be completed and signed for with the agent of Cavan Equestrian Centre or in the main office.

Any horse purchased that is not transacted through the Auctioneers of Cavan Equestrian Centre the purchaser will be barred from participating in all future sales.
